

CCWD STAGE III MANDATORY WATER CONSERVATION MEASURES

IN EFFECT NOW FOR ALL CCWD RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS:

- All irrigation is prohibited between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m.
- Residential landscaping can only be watered on an odd/even day watering cycle.
 - Odd-numbered addresses: Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays.
 - Even-numbered addresses: Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.
 - No outdoor watering on Sundays.
- Filling of new pools and spas is prohibited, however topping off pools and spas is allowed. CCWD encourages pool and spa owners to use covers to avoid evaporative losses.
- Cleaning hardscape (e.g. houses, patios, driveways and sidewalks) with water is prohibited.
- Use of water in decorative fountains & recreational ponds at minimum to preserve aquatic life.

NOTES:

1. Violators of Stage III measures could be subject to: written warnings, flow restricting devices, fines of up to \$600 and legal action.

2. Non-CCWD customers with private wells are bound by statewide mandatory restrictions put into place by the State Water Resources Control Board. CCWD conservation measures are somewhat different than the statewide restrictions.

3. Organizations that provide water to fewer than 3,000 connections – like Blue Lake Springs – are required to reduce outdoor irrigation to no more than two days per week or implement other mandatory restrictions that achieve a comparable level of water savings.
