Dear Homeowners,

First and foremost, we hope that you and your loved ones are safe and healthy. We have received questions from the community about if and how COVID-19 will change the way we operate our venue. After careful consideration, I am excited to let you know that we plan to reopen while following CDC guidance to protect our swimmers, staff, and our community.

The health and safety of our swimmers, staff, and other patrons remains our highest priority. Below you will find a summary of actions we are taking to help ensure we are lowering COVID-19 risk as much as possible while also allowing our swimmers and patrons to enjoy the water. We are:

- Promoting healthy hygiene practices, such as encouraging all homeowners, and guests to stay home if they are unwell, wash their hands frequently, cover coughs and sneezes, wearing cloth face coverings when not in the water.
 - Cloth face coverings ***should not be placed*** on children younger than 2 years of age, anyone who has trouble breathing, or is unconscious, incapacitated, or otherwise unable to remove the cover without assistance.
- Increasing cleaning and disinfection within our facilities by cleaning and disinfecting frequently touched surfaces, such as handrails, lounge chairs, and door handles. We are also having adequate soap, hand sanitizer at check-in, paper towels and no-touch trash cans. We have closed the snack bar and are not supplying floatation equipment. If you wish to use floatation equipment, you must bring your own and please refrain from sharing with others not in your party. If some in your party use the playground equipment, please use county guidelines and common sense.
- Encouraging social distancing when possible. We have changed deck layout to ensure patrons can remain 6 feet apart. There are 9 marked areas. Once you have selected an area, please stay in that area. If you need additional chairs, please inform the attendant. The 9 areas should be sufficient to handle most days. Family groups are welcome but please do not bring additional guests. During crowded weekends, you should plan to spend an hour at the pool. If the pool is underutilized, you are welcome to stay longer.

- Asking you for a contact phone number. The person at that number should know how to contact all others in their party in the event that contact tracing becomes needed.
- Posting signage throughout the area to remind you of the practices recommended to keep the area safe.
- Currently not allowing evening rental of the pool and we are not sponsoring group activities such as the Independence Day BBQ

If you have a specific question about this plan or COVID-19, please ask the attendant for more information. We will keep you informed of any additional guidelines that come from the county. We look forward to seeing you. Now, let's dive in and have fun!
