Lisa,

This email is to provide you with an update on the most recent findings related to the Lilac Park well complaints. In response to a recently received EPA complaint report alleging a "pit well" underneath the shed within the Lilac Park pool enclosure that is negatively impacting/affecting the aquifer. On September 19, 2023, I conducted a site visit/inspection to investigate the alleged complaints. At the time of inspection, I did not observe a pit well at the alleged location. I inspected the following locations:

- 1. Inside of the shed located within the pool enclosure. I lifted all of the stored items inside of this shed to ensure that a pit well was not underneath any of the stored items.
- 2. Underneath the shed located within the pool enclosure. I inspected all four sides underneath this shed.
- 3. The entire perimeter of the same shed, which is surrounded by the retaining wall that was mentioned in the complaint.
- 4. All areas adjacent to this same shed.
- 5. All rooms with locked doors within the pool enclosure were opened, and I inspected inside all of these rooms for a pit well.
- 6. The entire perimeter outside and around the pool enclosure.

I took photos of everything listed directly above and will place them inside of the complaint file.
